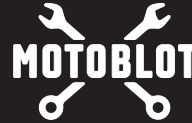

Accident Scene Management Class Hosted By Toys For Tots!

Do you know what to do if you witness or come upon an accident scene? Could you assist until EMS arrives? What should you do first? How do you secure the scene? Should you remove a rider's helmet? These are some of the important skills that you will learn upon attending an **ASM** class.

Toys For Tots partnered with the Road Guardians to host a **Level 100 Accident Scene Management Class (ASM)** in early April. The class was held on April 1st, at the Rhine VFW Post located on Archer Avenue in Chicago. Belinda Farrelly and Larry "Bear" Stotts conducted the class.

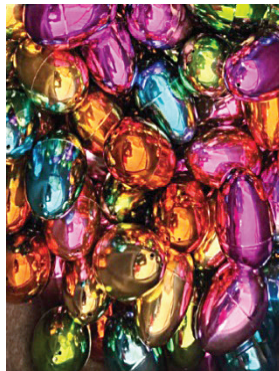

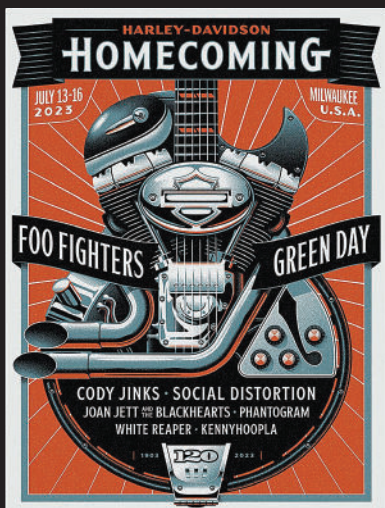

How Cold Will It Be While Riding?

It's May, the temperatures are warming up.....or are they? It may feel like nice weather when you walk outside, but how will it feel when you're riding down the road at 60 mph?

Make sure that you are dressed properly for the weather. There is nothing worse than being cold when you're out riding. Temperatures can be deceiving. The air temperature may be 50 degrees, but when you're traveling at 60 mph it feels like 39 degrees.

Check the **Cycle Fish Motorcycle Wind Chill Chart** for guidelines on what the "riding" temperature will feel like and dress appropriately. You'll be more comfortable and have a more enjoyable ride.

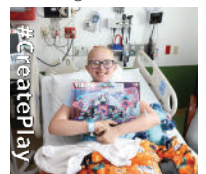
