## All Kids Bike Makes Kids From Sidney Sawyer Elementary School Happy!

It was a busy day that began with building all the bikes. We partnered with **Ángeles Del Silencio LEMC** (as we did last year) and they helped us put together the 24 Strider bikes along with the instructor bike and 2 rolling storage racks. Once everything was assembled, we hung all the bikes on the storage racks and covered them up with our **Motorcycle Safety Lawyers<sup>®</sup>** banners.

At this point, approximately 80 kindergarteners entered the gym and sat down. # April is Check Your Helmet Month!

The month of April is known as “**Check Your Helmet Month.**” And since your helmet is your first line of defense when you ride, it is important to take the time to make sure it is in prime condition.

Helmet materials contain high density foam which tends to degrade over time due to sun exposure, oxygen and sweat. Even with proper care and storage, as the foam degrades, it becomes less able to absorb impacts to the helmet. The helmet's shell can also become brittle and more prone to shattering, which can lead to a bad result.

It is important that you regularly check your motorcycle helmet for age, fit, signs of wear like dents or cracks in the shell, fraying straps, and replace helmets when necessary.

It's time to replace your helmet if:

- It's old or you dropped it – every 3 to 5 years is a good benchmark
- The padding and straps are worn
- The fit is no longer snug
- There are scratches, dents or cracks

## Motorcycle Safety Foundation Declares April As Distracted Driving Awareness Month!

April is National Distracted Driving Awareness Month, and the focus is on reducing fatalities caused by texting and phone use while driving. Distracted driving can include texting, using apps, eating, or adjusting your in-dash system while driving.

Some options include:

- Need to send a text? Pull over and park your car safely
- Designate a passenger as your “designated texter” to answer calls and respond to messages.
- Don't scroll through apps while driving. If you struggle not to text and drive then place the cell phone in the trunk, glove box, or back seat of the vehicle until you arrive at your destination.



Since April begins the riding season in many different states, the Motorcycle Safety Foundation (MSF) encourages drivers to expect to SEE motorcyclists on the road. The warmer weather returns in April and it's a busy month for bikers with numerous rallies, charity rides and bike nights. It is extremely important for car and truck drivers to be aware of motorcycles in the traffic mix and to look carefully before changing lanes or turning at intersections. Motorcycles are smaller and may be hiding in your blind spot.

Drive responsibly. Be vigilant and **put away** those cell phones. When you drive distracted, you're robbing yourself of seconds that you may need to avoid a close call or deadly crash. Everyone's safety is at stake!

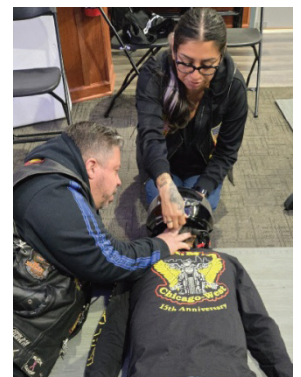
